VIRTUS Reminder

Volunteers who assist with school activities on a regular basis MUST attend VIRTUS: *Protecting God’s Children workshop* (Safe Environment Program) and successfully complete a background clearance prior to engaging in volunteer services. "Regular contact" with children here at St. Francis de Sales School includes, for example, volunteering in the classrooms (i.e., class party helper, field trip chaperone, parent reader), for carline, for selling concessions at sporting events, and even to have lunch with your child AND his/her friends.

Committee Descriptions

Blue & Gold Awards – Assist in the planning of the yearly sports award banquet

Do-Dads – Committee of dads who help with special projects around the school

Field Day – Work with PTO to plan, set up, work and clean-up for event

Grade Coordinator – Work with teacher and parents to coordinate events for their grade level; includes Christmas party, end of year party, teacher appreciation lunch and carline

Grandparent's Day – Volunteers help with set up and food preparation the day before, and serving and clean-up at the event

Hospitality – Assist committee coordinator with refreshments, set up and clean-up needed at PTO events / Open Houses

Library Christmas Shop / Book Fair – Assist the librarian with setting up, sales, and checkout for these fundraisers for the school library - Christmas Shop is in early December and Donate a Book Fair is during Catholic Schools Week

New Family Ambassador – Volunteers will be assigned a new family to the school. They will help answer general questions about the school events. This position is for both parents and children.

Picture Day Helper – Help organize the children having their pictures taken

PTO Family Picnic – This event is on September 12th from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Volunteers will help organize, set up, work and clean-up for the event.

Spaghetti Dinner – Volunteers will assist Steps for Students Committee throughout the event: set up, decorate, cook, serve and clean-up.

Sparkle Day – Community / grounds beautification effort

Steps for Students Committee – Assist in planning school activities and promotions around the school for the annual Archdiocesan 5K Run/Walk which helps support our school's budget

Teacher Appreciation Week – Assists planning events for a week in May – includes a luncheon

Weekly Library Volunteer – Volunteer to work one day a week to help the librarian with check-in / check-out and assist with students
