

Leap Into Third Grade Summer Requirements



Students should set aside time every day to READ! **Goal** is to read a chapter book a week.

*Studies have shown that students who read 20+ minutes a day are ranked in the 90th percentile on tests of reading achievement.

*Students should be reading chapter books that are **at least** one (1) point and at a third grade reading level or higher.

Come visit the SFdS Library during the summer to take AR quizzes. Parents must stay with their children.

Tuesdays 5-7 pm (6/12, 6/19, 6/26, 7/10, 7/17, 7/24)

Wednesdays 12-2 pm (6/13, 6/20, 6/27, 7/11, 7/18, 7/25)

SUMMER REQUIREMENTS:

- **Pass** (80% or better) **three tests** on Accelerated Reader books at or above their reading level.

OR

Write three book reports. Form available on our website.

These will count for a Reading grade in the 1st quarter.

- **Keep a journal** listing books read and a record of flash card practice. In addition, the journal should include sentences written about summer events, travel, and other summer experiences. The students set up their journal in school before the end of the school year. This will count as an English grade in the 1st quarter.
- **MATHLETICS:** Each student is expected to **earn four Mathletics Certificates** during the summer. These will count as a Math grade in the 1st quarter.
