

Leap Into Second Grade Summer Requirements



*Students should read ALOUD daily with a parent

*Please choose a variety of titles and authors on an appropriate level

*Studies have shown that students who read 20+ minutes a day are ranked in the 90th percentile on tests of reading achievement.

*Come visit the SFdS Library throughout the summer to take AR quizzes. Please see school calendar for weeks the library is open.

June 12&13,19&20, and 26&27. July 10&11,17&18,24&25 and last day the 31st

Students are required to:

- **Pass EIGHT (8) tests** on Accelerated Reader books at or above their reading level.

OR

Write three book reports. Form available on our website.

- **Keep a journal** listing books read and a record of math activities. In addition, the journal should include sentences written about summer events, travel, and other summer experiences. He or she will be setting up the journal in school before the end of the school year. The journal will be shared with the class in August.

MATHLETICS

Each student is expected to earn at least **FOUR (4) Mathletics Certificates** during the summer.

To earn a certificate, student must earn 1,000 points in one week.
