



# COVID-19 Protocols

## SFds Site-Based COVID Response

These guidelines have been reviewed and approved by Fr. Joseph and the SFds Advisory School Board. Because the pandemic is presenting ever changing information, the following protocols are subject to change at any time.

### LEVEL 1 CAMPUS

(LESS THAN 1% [3] OF POPULATION HAS ACTIVE COVID POSITIVE TEST)

#### Follow the Return to School Plan with the following changes:

- Masks strongly recommended
- Lunch rotation between classroom, outside, and cafeteria
- Students may move to ancillary/elective classes
- Guardian angels and cherubs may sit together at Mass

### LEVEL 2 CAMPUS

(1% [4] OF OR MORE OF SFDS SCHOOL STUDENT, TEACHERS, AND STAFF HAS ACTIVE COVID POSITIVE TEST AND A MINIMAL TEACHER SHORTAGE EXIST; WHEN CASES FALL BELOW 1% MOVE TO LEVEL 1)

#### Follow Level 1 protocols with the following changes:

- Masks required
- Quarantine or close classes, grade levels, and/or extra-curriculars as deemed necessary (If 10% of a class or grade level is COVID positive, the class or grade level must quarantine from events and extra-curriculars)
- Limited masked and screened volunteers and/or visitors on campus (Room coordinators and those with appointments only)
- Screened visitors for indoor events
- Planned school events moved outside if possible

### LEVEL 3 CAMPUS

(5% [14] OR MORE OF SFDS SCHOOL STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND STAFF HAS ACTIVE COVID POSITIVE TEST AND A MODERATE TEACHER SHORTAGE EXISTS; WHEN CASES FALL BELOW 5% MOVE TO LEVEL 2)

#### Follow Level 1 and 2 protocols with the following changes:

- Add Plexi-glass to common spaces when social distancing is not possible
- Limit school mass and event attendance
- No visitors on campus
- Lunch in classrooms; cafeteria is closed
- Additional reminders to the school community to encourage hand washing, proper mask wearing, social distancing, symptom monitoring (provide wording & link from most recent CDC document), etc.

### LEVEL 4 CAMPUS

(10% [27] OR MORE OF SFDS SCHOOL STUDENTS, TEACHERS, AND STAFF HAS ACTIVE COVID AND A SEVERE TEACHER SHORTAGE EXISTS; WHEN CASES FALL BELOW 10% MOVE TO LEVEL 3)

#### Follow Level 1, 2, and 3 protocols with the following additions:

- Close school for in-person learning, transition to virtual learning, and contact Harris County Public Health Department for further instruction
- Cease extra-curricular school activities and field trips

### LEVEL 5 SYSTEM WIDE

(ARCHDIOCESAN OR HEALTH DEPARTMENT ORDERS BASED ON WIDE-SPREAD RESURGENCE OF COVID)
